Shift from inhouse tools to SaaS

Plummer Joes definion between SaaS (Software as a Service) and Cloud computing:

”If your vendor can pinpoint the server where your service is hosted then it’s SaaS. If not then it’s in Cloud”

By no means look SaaS or Cloud as only DIY tools.
Expect the same or higher service level from your
vendor than with inhouse hosted software.

- Requires only minimum of own IT-personnel
- Typically fast and continuous updates
- Instant user support available

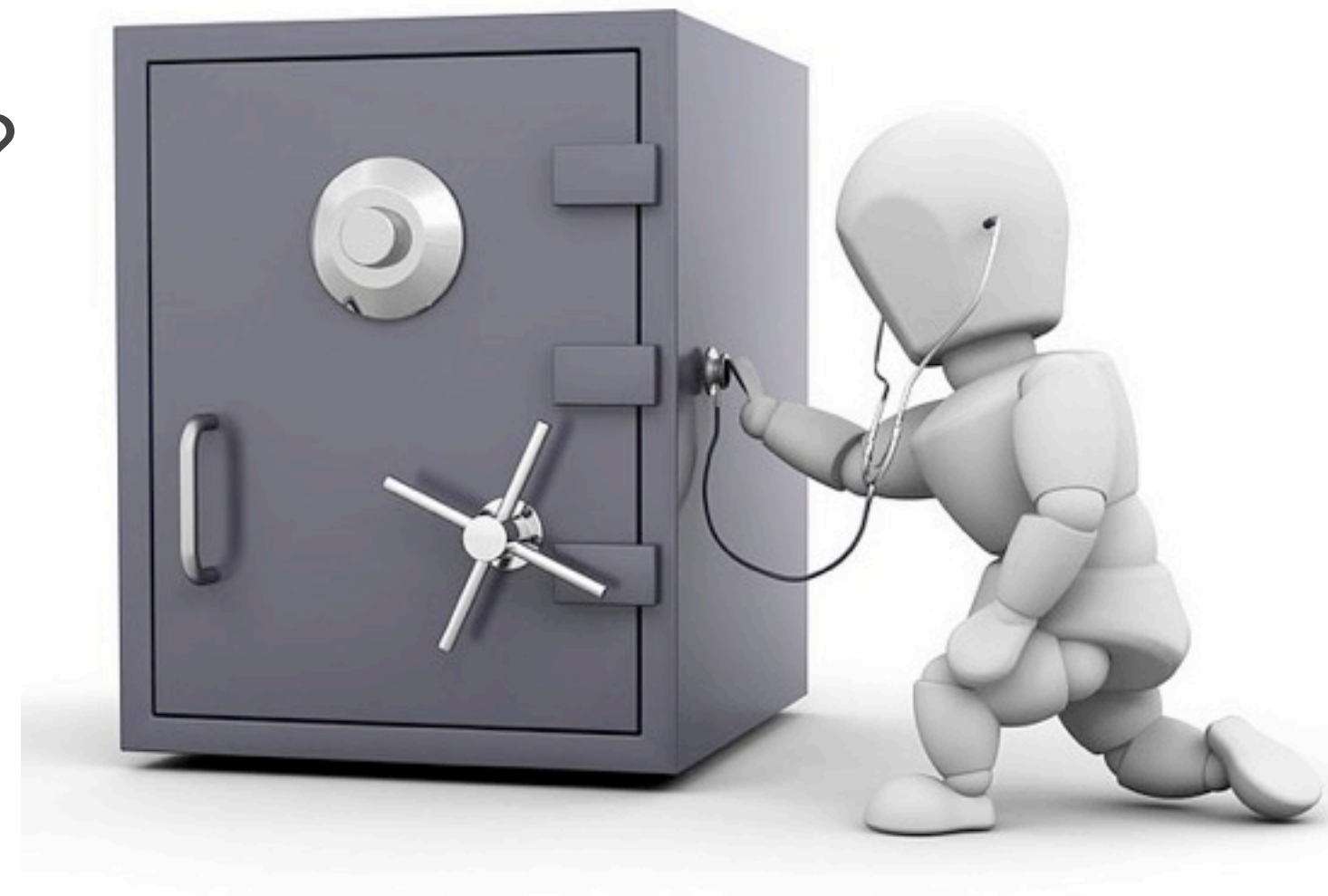
